The Sci Club Levico, in collaboration with FIS, FISI, Lavarone Ski, with the support of the municipalities of Lavarone, Levico Terme, and Luserna Lusérn, the tourist boards APT AlpeCimbra and Valsugana Lagorai, the Alta Valsugana and Bernstol Community, the Magnificent Community of the Cimbrian Highlands, Bim Brenta, Cassa Rurale Alta Valsugana, and Avis Levico Terme, will organize on August 13 and 14, 2025, three grass skiing races: special slalom, gymanahana, and giant slalom, valid as a stage of the International Youth Cup (Fis Children Cup) and Green Talent Finals (Italian Cup) of Grass Skiing. In the days preceding these races, from August 9 to 12, 2025, we will also host the World Youth Camp of grass skiing. The technical training, improvement sessions, and races will be held at the Grass Skiing Center managed by the Sci Club Levico in Rivetta Luserna and on the Vezzena Levico Terme slope. All the best grass skiing athletes in the world (aged between 7 and 21 years), coming from countries such as Austria, France, Germany, Japan, India, Iran, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Russia, Sweden, Switzerland, Taiwan, and naturally Italy, will be hosted at the Grass Ski Village Vezzena (hereinafter referred to as GSVV). The athletes will stay in the same building, sharing accommodations and all common areas of the structure. On Sunday, August 10, 2025, at 8:30 PM, the opening ceremony will take place along the streets of downtown Levico Terme, with the parade of all delegations. During the week, guided tours and recreational activities will also be organized, along with round tables featuring discipline technicians, sports doctors, and coaches who will share their experiences from their respective countries with the athletes, exchanging opinions and methods to ensure the camp offers not only great sporting value but also cultural and social enrichment. Following the success already achieved by Sci Club Levico with the events assigned by FIS and organized in 2016 and 2022, we aim once again to showcase the best image of Italy, Trentino, Levico Terme, and our valleys to the world — along with the healthy values that Sci Club Levico fosters for youth sports. For athletes, the stay includes: Full board at the GSVV from August 9 (dinner) to August 15 (breakfast) – 6 nights, Registration to the three (3) races scheduled for Wednesday, August 13, and Thursday, August 14.

The total cost is €350.00 (three hundred fifty euros). The fee will be refundable, fully or partially, only in case of serious personal issues preventing participation.

After all athletes and their guardians have been accommodated and registered, if there are still available spots at the GSVV, they will be assigned chronologically to other accompanying persons at the cost of €60.00 per day or €360.00 for the entire stay (6 nights) with full board. It is also possible to have lunch and/or dinner at the GSVV by purchasing meal vouchers the evening before at a cost of €15.00 per meal.

STAY AT THE GRASS SKI VILLAGE VEZZENA CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

The facility that will host the athletes and their authorized accompanying persons (as specified below) is called the Grass Ski Village Vezzena, located at the Vezzena Plateau colony in the municipality of Levico Terme - Trentino - Italy, and entirely managed by the event's organizing body "SCI CLUB LEVICO - GRASS SKI TEAM LEVICO." Check-in will be available starting from 3:00 PM on Saturday, August 9, 2025. Athletes participating in the camp will be accommodated at the GSVV. For every ten (10) athletes per nation, one accompanying person will be offered free accommodation; for every additional ten athletes, one more adult accompanying person will be hosted free of charge. Accommodation means that all athletes and these accompanying persons may stay at the GSVV, with sleeping arrangements in the designated sleeping area and access to the dining area. At check-in, each registered athlete and accompanying person will receive an identification wristband, which must be worn at all times inside the facility and also presented at the Grass Ski Center in Rivetta Luserna Lusérn (where the technical training sessions and competitions will take place).

This identification wristband grants access to the GSVV, the sleeping quarters, restrooms and showers, the dining area, and the workshop. Along with the wristband, each participant will receive a document containing the rules of conduct for the GSVV and the Rivetta Grass Ski Center. It is also possible for people not staying at the GSVV to purchase meal vouchers for €15.00 (fifteen euros) each, available the evening before at the GSVV reception, allowing them to dine at the GSVV dining area. The return to the GSVV sleeping quarters must occur no later than 11:30 PM. Nighttime re-entry, even for a single athlete, will only be allowed if their designated accompanying person (registered during check-in) is present inside the sleeping area. All those registered at the GSVV will have access to the spaces within the Baby Rivetta slope at the Rivetta Luserna Lusérn Grass Ski Center for camp activities and competitions. They will also have access to the ski lifts (skilift and conveyor belt) and to the designated areas for ski washing and preparation (note: ski equipment cannot be washed at the GSVV premises).

However, maintenance work on the skis can be performed by accessing the workshop located within the GSVV, using the available equipment.

RULES

The rules are intended to ensure equal rights and responsibilities for all, promoting the well-being of all participants — young athletes, families, coaches, and the technical, organizational, and management staff. These rules must be consciously accepted and not simply endured, as any community, even the smallest, requires rules to allow for civil and safe coexistence.

Rules of the GSVV and Rivetta Grass Ski Center

ART. 1 Every athlete must:

- Strictly adhere to the schedule of activities;
- Follow the guidance of adult staff members;
- Attend diligently to their residential duties;
- Wear appropriate and respectable clothing;
- Maintain civic behavior at all times and in all places.

Personal hygiene, proper attire, cleanliness of shared spaces, and respect for furnishings are essential educational values that must characterize behavior at the GSVV, the Rivetta Grass Ski Center, and all other event-related venues.

In the bedrooms, silence, tidiness, cleanliness, and mutual respect must be maintained, avoiding loud noises and ensuring the proper periods of rest. Personal hygiene must be taken care of, and rooms and belongings must be kept orderly. No athlete is allowed to enter another athlete's room without permission and the presence of its occupants.

ART. 2 Athletes' behavior and language must always be respectful and appropriate.

ART. 3 Blasphemy, vulgar language, and obscene or violent publications and shows are strictly prohibited.

ART. 4 It is forbidden to possess alcoholic beverages.

ART. 5 Smoking is strictly prohibited in all GSVV accommodations.

ART. 6 Athletes are forbidden from entering the rooms of accompanying persons or any other restricted areas of the GSVV without prior authorization.

ART. 7 Access is permitted to the sleeping quarters (nighttime area), the dining area, the restroom and shower facilities, and the courtyard (recreational area). Access to the workshop or any other areas of the GSVV must be requested and authorized, and always under adult supervision.

**Any damage caused to the facilities or movable property
due to improper use must be compensated.**

**The direction committee declines all responsibility for damages to persons or property
resulting from improper use of equipment.**

**The committee is also not responsible for the loss or theft of objects, valuables,
or anything else within the GSVV and the Rivetta Grass Ski Center.**

In the event of health-related issues, the custodial staff must be alerted. Athletes must immediately notify their designated accompanying person, who will then alert the emergency services based on the severity of the situation. The athlete's family will be informed and, if present locally, will be invited to the GSVV and, if necessary, accompanied to the hospital facility.
